- 2. Inspect the three lower studs that come through the housing and drop out. Clean with a wire brush if needed so that the threads will not be galled when removing the nuts.
- 3. Hold the mounting bracket up to the three lower stud nuts; these will be the nuts to remove. Remove nuts and place the bracket on the housing so that the angled side with two slotted holes points toward the rear of the vehicle. Replace and retighten the nuts.
- 4. Hold the main lower plate in position so that the counter sunk holes aligns with the slotted holes in the mounting bracket. Take note of which pinion housing bolts need to be removed. Remove the bolts, put main lower plate in place and secure using the previously removed bolts.
- 5. Using the 3/8" socket cap screws, 3/8" nyloc nut, and 3/8" washers, secure the main lower plate to the mounting bracket.
